Commitment to Achieving Net Zero

Legacie Contracts Ltd (LCL) is fully committed to achieving **Net Zero greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by 2050**, in line with the UK Government’s statutory Net Zero target.

This commitment meets the mandatory requirement for all suppliers bidding on major public sector contracts under **PPN 006 (formerly PPN 06/21)**.

Organisational Boundary

This Carbon Reduction Plan covers:

- Legacie Contracts Ltd head office and satellite workplaces
- All construction, refurbishment and property-improvement activities
- Fleet vehicles used by LCL
- Direct employees and subcontractor activities where LCL controls processes

It aligns with the **GHG Protocol** and the categories required within PPN 006 carbon reporting.

Emissions Baseline Year (2024/25)

LCL’s baseline year is **1 Oct 2024 – 30 Sept 2025**.

This is the first year LCL has calculated a full organisational carbon footprint, forming the basis for all future comparison in accordance with the government’s technical standard.

Carbon Reduction Targets

To support Net Zero by 2050, LCL commits to:

Near-term Targets (by 2030)

- 40% reduction in Scope 1 and 2 emissions
- 25% reduction in selected Scope 3 categories
- Transition 50% of fleet to electric vehicles
- 100% renewable electricity across all offices and site compounds

Long-term Target

- **Achieve Net Zero no later than 2050**, consistent with government expectations.

Carbon Reduction Measures

LCL has implemented or plans to implement the following measures to reduce emissions:

Energy & Buildings

- Switch to **100% renewable electricity** contracts by 2027
- LED lighting upgrades across all locations
- Sub-metering and smart monitoring for energy hotspots

Fleet & Travel

- Electrification of van fleet (phased to 2030)
- Anti-idling policy on all sites
- Encourage public transport and car-share for commuting

Construction & Site Operations

- Reduced deliveries with consolidated logistics hubs
- Local procurement to minimise transport emissions
- Use of recycled aggregates and low-carbon materials
- Mandatory waste-segregation zones across sites

Corporate Operations

- Adoption of digital workflows to reduce paper and travel
- Remote meeting default policy to minimise inter-office travel

Future Measures

- Introduction of carbon-tracking software for sites
- Embodied carbon reduction targets integrated into material procurement

All actions above meet the requirement for CRPs to outline past and planned initiatives.

Governance & Responsibility

The Carbon Reduction Plan is overseen by:

- **Colin Campbell – Operations Director**
- LCL Sustainability Steering Group
- Site Managers and Project Leads, who implement site-level controls
- Approved subcontractors, who must comply with LCL environmental policies

The CRP meets the requirement for **director-level sign-off** under PPN 006.
